1. When approaching the pedestrian crossing, what should the driver do in this situation?



1. Maintain speed, because the pedestrians have not stepped on to the crossing.
2. Continue to drive on fast because the pedestrians have to wait.
3. **Slow down in good time and be prepared to stop.**
4. Sound the horn to draw attention to your vehicle and continue to drive at the same speed.

2. **What should a motorcycle rider do when he steps on the foot brake, but the foot brake doesn't function?**

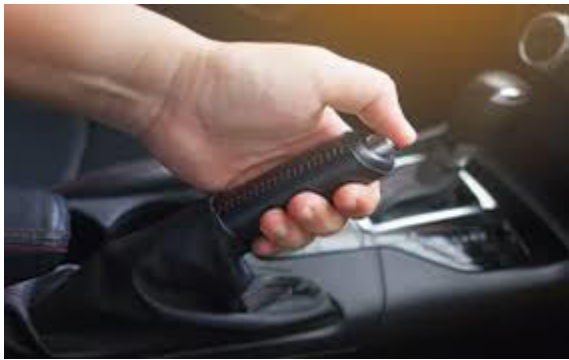
- a. He should try to brake by strongly pressing the clutch handle.
- b. **He should try to brake by using the hand brake (front brake) and by shifting into low gear.**
- c. He should brake by shifting to lower gears only.
- d. He should turn the handlebar to the right in order to brake through the change of the front wheel's direction.

3. What should a driver be most aware of when approaching a vehicle which is attempting to park?

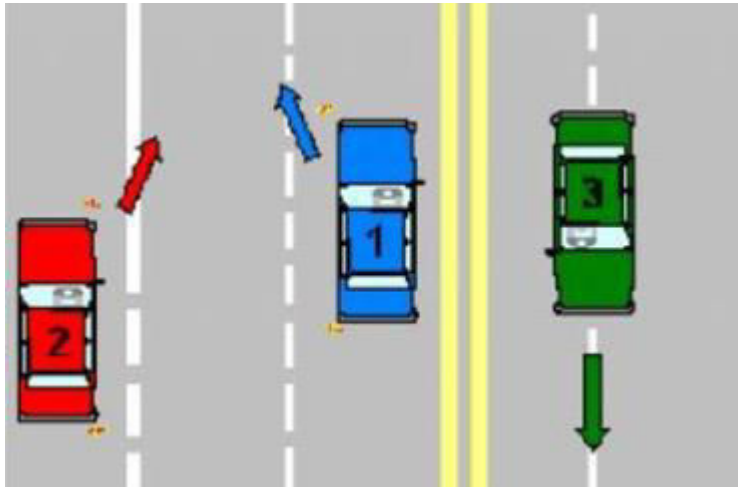

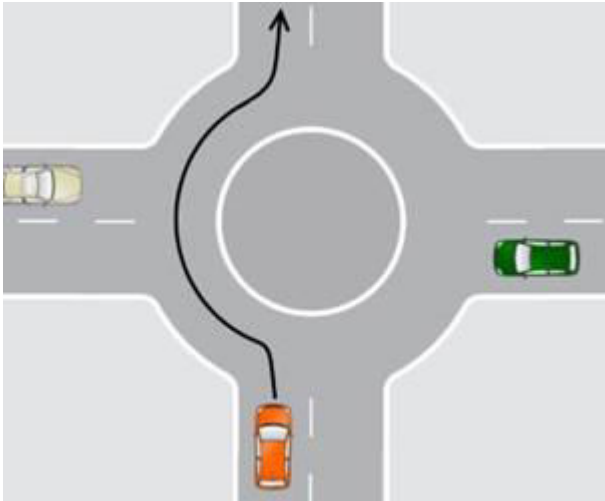
